BIKES FOR TYKES

Objective: To provide a bike as a Christmas present to an unsuspecting child.

There will be plenty of fun, hard work and mechanical challenges in this program with a twist. With delegates having to solve challenges, work together as a team and build a dismantled bike it may all seem like a big challenge. But a smile on the face of an underprivileged child will make it all worthwhile.

PROGRAM

Teams are formed and an immediate brief is given into the outline of the day's activities and agenda. Each team's ultimate goal is to rebuild a bicycle that has been dismantled. Each team must successfully complete a series of tasks and challenges in order to earn the pieces of their bike. Under time constraints the teams work their way through this series of initiative tasks and challenges. Tasks can be undertaken indoors or outdoors, and will be designed to suit your objectives.

Once an activity has been completed, teams will be given a document card that provides them a certain piece of the bike. Activities will continue with all pieces of the bike and the tool kit available for redemption upon successful completion of the chosen activities. Once all activities are complete, teams will then take their document cards to the facilitator to collect their various bike pieces. If a team has successfully acquired all they need to build their bike, they may start immediately. If a team is missing a document card (and ultimately a piece of the bike) they must complete an extra activity in order to earn the final piece or pieces.

With the bike fully built, each team must bring their bike to a qualified mechanic who will give the bike the "once over" and report on any defects to the judges. The team to do this first (and pass the test 100%) will be crowned champions for the day. Up until this point the delegates still think that this is just an exercise in team dynamics.

Later, a presentation ceremony will be held to announce the winning team, as we call upon children from a local charity group to come and present the medals to the winning team. With medals presented, the kids will all make their way to each team to receive the bikes from the delegates. What results is a frantic re-checking and adjusting of the bikes to suit the kids and to make them safe. It is this dramatic change from a fun team - building exercise into a very real scenario that gives the program its power. The change in the delegates now that the outcome is "real" is often quite staggering.

CHRISTMAS MUSIC AWARDS

Objective: To showcase your music knowledge and produce your own music video.

PROGRAM

"Ladies and Gentlemen.....Welcome to your Christmas Music Awards....."

The program begins with a series of music trivia activities testing even the most accomplished critic. Teams will face off testing their musical knowledge across different genres ranging from Hip Hop, Rock, Country, Pop, Soul, and Jazz or Christmas Jingles. Each activity will see teams vying for music points that will later prove invaluable as we get down the business end of the program.

As we move to the all important auction, your performance in the music trivia will either reward you with your choice of equipment or leave you playing catch up! Teams will have the opportunity to use their previously acquired music points to bid on a range of props and resources, and most importantly, the song with which teams will create their own music video!

As the **teams** finish their preparations the air of expectation heightens. Each team will be assigned a 30 second song, a portable stereo, and a video camera. The rest, my friends, is up to you!

It's time to unleash the super star within. Armed with your song and whatever bonus items you have been able to acquire, teams will be given their portable stereo, video camera and the license to get creative. A vast array of back-up dancers, special effects, lighting, filming crews and digital editing equipment will not be available to you! Instead you will be challenged to shoot your music video in one shot from start to finish. You can have as many attempts as you like but you must produce one clip that will exceed all expectations and conquer all others!

As teams report to the Idol Arena the judges will be ready to critique the creative from the norm and the professional from the amateur as each music video is played for all to see. As the judges ready their feedback and mark their scores there is nothing you can do but sit back and enjoy the show. CHRISTMAS CLUEDO

Objective: To be the first team to discover WHO STOLE SANTA'S TOYS!

Your objective in Christmas Cluedo is to sift through the evidence on file, decipher the clues left behind by the syndicate, work well as a team and ultimately discover the names of the men wanted over this newly appeared toy smuggling ring.

PROGRAM

This mystery is going to take some solving.....

As the **teams** arrive they will be allocated to the current case and given an up to date police file. They must read through their instructions, sift through the mounds of evidence and set up a strategy as they utilise compulsory planning time given to them. Teams will be told of the need to assist the police, the CIA, and the FBI to apprehend these Sierra Leone based criminals now operating in Australia.

Teams must work hard to open a nominated safe and complete the CLUEDO task that is inside. By finding the identity of the person that **"drives the Sleigh and the person that deals toy trucks"** the powers that be will be able to swoop on their suspects.

Upon completion of the brief, teams must make their way to a nominated location to begin gathering the required information. Throughout the program the teams will race to solve a variety of recreational or problem solving activities (these can be selected to suit the needs and wants of your company). As teams successfully complete tasks they will be given clues to the combination of the safe that hold further challenges.

In the safe will be the information needed to answer the 2 questions asked in the mission kit – who drives the sleigh and who deals toy trucks. Teams must work their way through all the information provided to come up with the correct answers. The first team to do so will be crowned CLUEDO Champions.

CHRISTMAS DINNER

Objective: Impress the judges where it counts most..... their taste buds!!

By providing tasks for all team members to create the ultimate Christmas Dinner, teams must work together on all aspects of Christmas dining to work with the materials and ingredients provided to whip up the perfect culinary and dining experience.

All **teams** will meet for a team briefing held by Corporate Challenge, as rules and objectives will be outlined. Teams will be told of their need to design and prepare a "signature Christmas meal" and a "dining experience" that will be judged on many variables by an expert panel.

Teams must then delegate roles, to include the **hunters and gatherers** (those who head to the shops to get vital ingredients), the **designers & decorators** (those who will set the ambience for the dinner with tables settings and the appropriate mood) and of course the **chefs** (those who will be hands on in the kitchen with a chef).

During compulsory planning time each team will allocate tasks, decide on a menu, decide on a theme and target market for their meal, design a wine list and prepare a budget. The three groups will then head out to commence the task of creating the ultimate dining experience.

1. Basics such as tables and chairs will be available for the designers & decorators
2. Chefs will be on hand in the "kitchen" to assist teams with the preparation of the meal.
3. A local market or a mystery box of ingredients will be made available to the hunters and gatherers.

When all tasks are completed, teams will come together as one for the final touches to their experience and the final serving of the meals to their table and to the Head Chef (Teams cook one meal for each team member and one for the judging panel).

The judges will then visit each table to judge their signature dish, their menu, their wine and rate the overall ambience of their dining experience. From this a winning team will be announced, and the spoils of victory awarded to them.

CHRISTMAS RACES

Objective: To be part of the winning syndicate at the end of the day.

Get out your big hats, dust off the old suits and get ready for an afternoon/evening of good old fashioned fun. The Corporate Challenge Christmas Races will test your group's ability to pick a winner when it comes to horse racing. The only unknown is whether you will be part of the winning syndicate at the end of the night.

PROGRAM

As our race goers enter the conference room or dinner venue they will be met by the Corporate Challenge bookies waiting in the betting ring. All delegates will then receive \$3,000.00 and a copy of the 2010 form guide. In the race guide, delegates will notice that the jockeys are actually delegates within the group! A briefing into the event will then be given by the chief steward.

Throughout the race meet there will be a full set of races run with everything from maidens, group ones, fillies and other specialty breeds battling to pass the finishing post first. Delegates will be given a period of time between each race to study the guide, compare the options and place a winning bet with the bookies. With bets such as on the nose, place, each way, trifecta, quinella, exacta, quadrella and daily double being accepted there will be no shortage of options for the die hard punter or the novice race goer at our betting ring. They will receive their betting stub and then move trackside ready for the race.

A large screen at the front of the room will telecast all races allowing the punters to see the action. With real horses, real callers and real jockeys battling it out this will be as close to the real thing as you can get. After each race the bookies will pay out to the winning punters and we will move on to the next race.

At the end of the race day our punters will undoubtedly have pockets full of cash. The final item on our schedule will be a famous race such as the Kentucky Derby or the Grand National. The horses will be paraded for all to see and punters will form syndicates. It will then be an old fashioned Calcutta as our syndicates buy, through auction, the horse of their choice. The race to end all races will then be run – with teams either ending up in the gutter or in the member's tent.

PROGRAM

All delegates make their way from your office by Helicopter or Hummer Limousines! This first journey will be the start to an eventful and memorable day. Upon arrival at a mystery location, delegates will be greeted by a Corporate Challenge facilitator; teams will be formed and told of the need to be the first to locate the Christmas Treasure.

Following a safety and instruction brief, the next mode of transport is presented to each team - Jet skis, minibuses, Harley Davidson's or mountain bikes depending on budget. With all instructions given, the team prepared and resources acquired (maps etc.) All delegates will now make their way to the awaiting transport. This mode of transport will allow delegates to arrive at activity stations in order to earn or find clues to the Christmas Treasure.

Teams will then hit the water/road and follow their first clue to arrive at activity station 1. Teams will complete their first task for a chance to earn a clue to the hidden treasure, before heading to location 2.

With all locations complete, teams will then race to find the hidden treasure. One team will emerge as champions, but both teams will enjoy the spoils of the treasure as they enjoy a treat of champagne and finger food - emerge with smiles on their faces and a great day of adventure behind them.

But wait..... A Jetboat / Hummer will then arrive to return the group to a location of your choice via a thrill ride!

The team can then enjoy dinner or lunch as they talk about the year gone and the day they all experienced together.

CHRISTMAS CRACKER-JACK

Objective: Get the bowl as close to the jack as possible. Simple!!!!

Get out the flat shoes, put on your Christmas costumes and prepare to ride the wild ride that is Christmas Lawn Bowls. Corporate Challenge would like to show your company the fun and enjoyment that can be had when you combine lawn bowls, sunshine, some cool drinks and some good people together for a few hours.

PROGRAM

To start the day the entire group will be given a brief into the **rules and objectives of Lawn Bowls**. Corporate Challenge will provide a quick demonstration on the technique involved with lawn bowling. Each delegate will then have a chance to practice through a series of un-structured games against any opposition. No points or scores are recorded, and this is classed as the warm up. Throughout the afternoon all delegates will also be able to enjoy drinks as they battle the greens.

After all delegates are familiar with the layout of the green and the weight of the balls we will enter the slightly more structured section of the program. Delegates will be put in teams of **2, 3 or 4** and will compete against other teams from the group. Two ends will be played (down and back) and the score will be recorded by the Corporate Challenge facilitators. Teams will continue in this fashion, competing against a different team every time, and recording their scores until all teams have played 5 - 8 games. By running the program in this fashion delegates will be able to play plenty of games but also get time to socialise and enjoy the venue. In these rounds Corporate Challenge will also throw in a few novelty variations such as left handed bowling, blindfolded bowling etc.

The lawn bowls tournament will continue through the afternoon with teams competing at a variety of different challenges eventually leading to the **"Final Knockout"**. Depending on the points gained, the team's enthusiasm and a number of other undisclosed factors a number of teams will enter this final round.

The Final Knockout will see the teams bowling off to find who will be crowned the **Corporate Challenge Lawn Bowls Champion**.
